POOL MAINTENANCE

- Keep your pool's chemistry in balance to prevent corrosion or scale buildup during the off-season.
- Make these adjustments 2-3 times a week.
- Shock the water with chlorine to kill bacteria.
- Add a winterized algaecide to kill blooming or existing algae.
- Clean the pool regularly by removing everything from the water as this can stain the interior of the pool.
- Make sure to check water features too!



Safety First

- Take the filter out and clean with hose
- Sand Filters: backwash weekly
- Have a professional test the mineral content of your water, total alkalinity, pH, and chlorine levels
- If you have interior calcium or mineral build up, talk to Texas Pool Works about an interior pool cleaning
- Shock the water with chlorine to kill bacteria.
- Do this in the evening as the sun will make it less effective.
- Dilute chemicals first by filling a bucket with water and add in the granular shock gradually.
- Mix well and pour into the pool with the pump running
- Maintain a clean filter
- Maintain proper water levels
- Vacuum pool each week
- Test chemicals 2-3 times a week
- Have a professional at Texas Pool Works test the water each month
- Run the pump during the day to maintain water circulation and keep the pool sanitized
- Only add chemicals when pool is running
- Open chemicals outdoors and away from face
- Add chemicals gradually
- Carefully handle leftover chemicals
